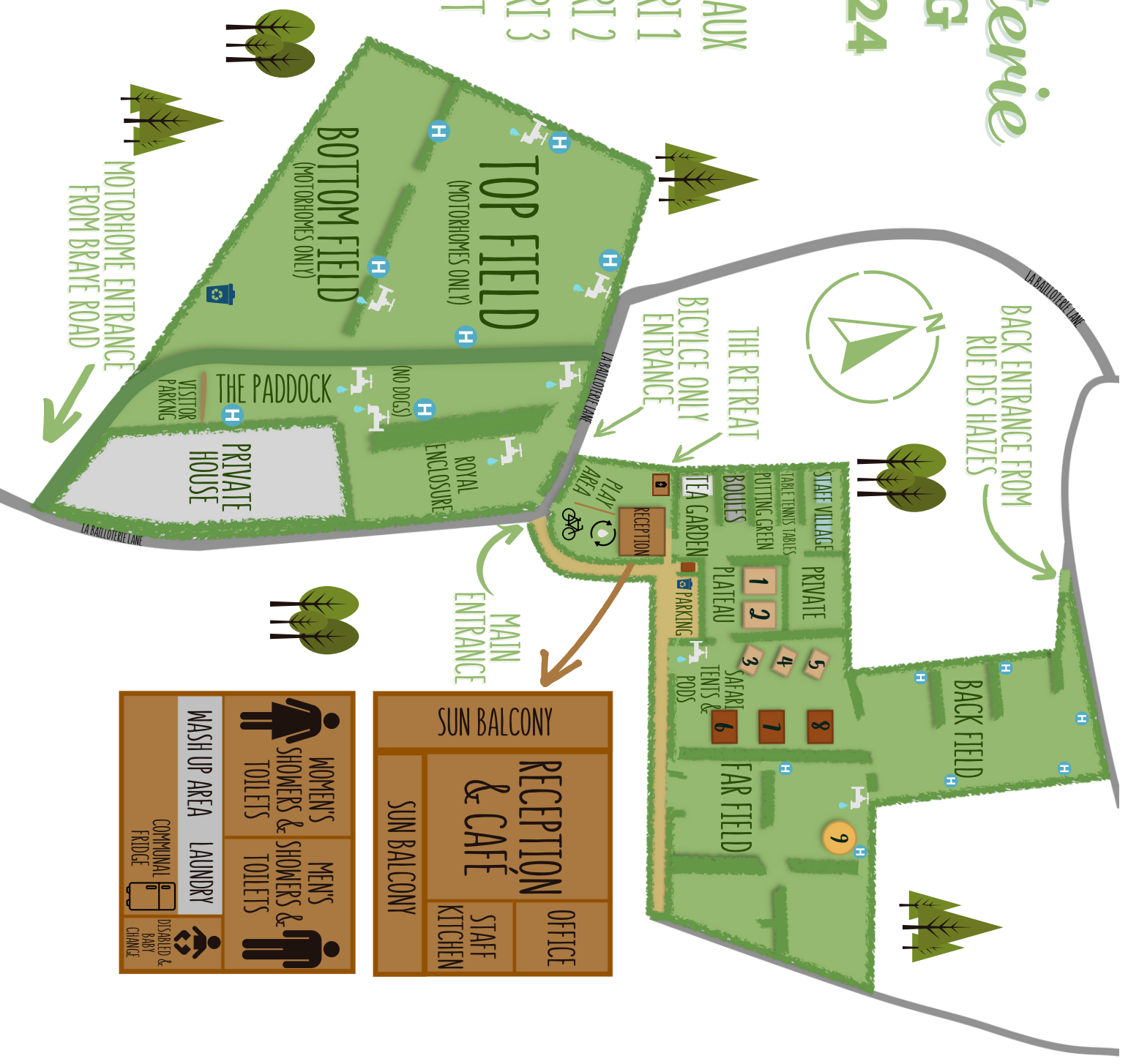

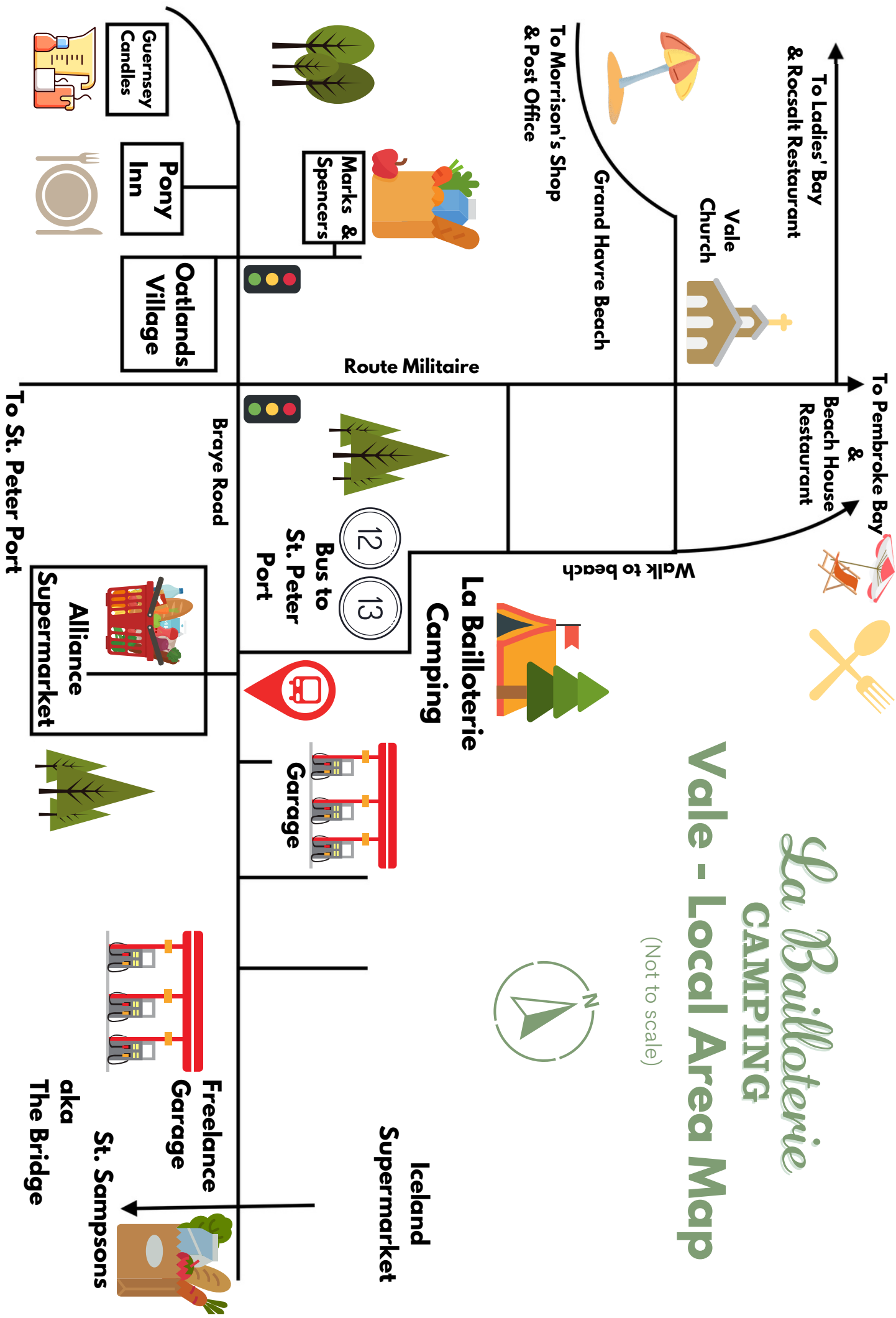

# Check-in and out...

## Check-in:

If you haven't already, **please check-in at the Barn** with a member of staff who will give you a quick tour of our facilities.

## Check-out:

Check-out time from our accommodation is **10.30am**. If you have not already done so, please **report any damage or loss to a member of staff**. Any such damage or loss will be charged proportionately. Please **remove all your food from the fridge** and place it and its packing in the bins.

Please make sure to sign into the visitors' diary at reception and settle any payment due with a member of staff!



## House rules:

We kindly ask all campers to be aware that at night, sound travels a long way.

Please respect the rights of the other campers to a peaceful night's sleep and keep all noise to a minimum after 11 pm.

We also ask that you do not smoke or light candles inside your Yurt.

# Facilities...

## In the Barn...

The **showers** and **toilets** can be found on the ground floor of the barn. Around the back of the barn, you will find a **wash-up area** and **baby change** as well as **washing machines and dryers**. A wash costs £5 and a dry costs £3. Please speak to a member of staff to access the machines.

## In your Yurt...

When using the cooker please select the **option required** then turn on the **power/timer control**. The door must be **left ajar** when using the **grill**.

Outside your Yurt you have a **BBQ**. Fuel can be purchased from the **Campsite shop** or **Gaudions at Camp du Roi**.

## Around the Site...

Around the site you will find **water taps**. All water on the site is drinkable. The nearest to your pod is at the top of the Far Field, **just next to your Yurt**. Wi-Fi is also available around the Barn and Tea Garden. Dependant on your device, it may reach to your Yurt. All passwords are camping1.

Enjoy a **calming tea break** on our **sunny south-facing balcony** overlooking the **children's playground**. A small souvenir shop is available.

Note: Food and drink available only in high season.

# Rubbish and Recycling



Here on **Guernsey**, we pride ourselves on our **73% recycling rate** for our household waste. To maintain this, **please place all rubbish** in the correct bins which are provided in your cabin.

In your accommodation you will find a:

**Small Grey Bin** - For food waste (no packaging).

**Small Mesh Bin** - Non-recyclable waste.

**Large Bin with Blue Lid** - For plastic recycling.

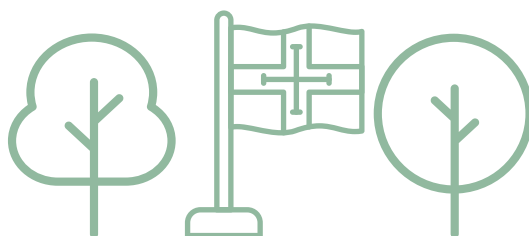
**Large Bin with Green Lid** - For paper and cardboard recycling.

**Your waste must be separated accordingly.**

If you **fill your bins**, please **empty them into the relevant bins** at the **end of the car park** or the **bottom motorhome field**. Please then **go to reception** for a **replacement bag**.

# Things to do and see...



## FOOD & DRINK

### Beach House at Pembroke

If you are feeling a little hungry and don't want to cook or drive, a short stroll through the lanes will take you to L'Ancrese Common turn right at the main road using the footpath and head for the beach. There you will find The Beach House, they serve meals until 8.30pm last orders 8pm in High Season and 7pm in Low Season (roughly 15/20 minute walk from the site).

### Alliance Supermarket

Our local supermarket is open from 7:30am to 7pm Monday to Saturday. 10am to 4pm on Sundays. Leave the campsite via the main entrance and walk down to the end of the lane, cross over the main road and Alliance is 75 metres on your right.

## ON-SITE ENTERTAINMENT

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(IN HIGH SEASON)

### BBQ or Chips & Cheese Nights

During High Season (weather permitting) the site hosts a BBQ or Chips and cheese night. Savour delicious local sausages, burgers and chips, all prepared just for you!

### Putting Green (opening 2024)

On the terrace above the Tea Garden, you'll find our brand new putting green course, offering hours of entertainment for occupants of our accommodations. Putters, balls, score cards, and pencils are readily available at Reception.

### Table Tennis

For a lively game of table tennis, we've provided two tables. Simply purchase a ball (35p) from the shop, and you're ready to play! Kindly return the bats to the basket located under the table when you're finished.

### Boules/Pentanque

Feel free to make use of the boules pitch, which is complimentary. Collect and sign for the boules set at Reception, and please ensure it's returned in full to the desk once playtime concludes.



**Guernsey** has 27 beaches to explore and relax on. From the wide sandy sweeps of the west and north coasts to the coves of the south, there really is something for everyone. While we can't fit everything in this short guide, we've picked a few of our local favourites!

## Pembroke & L'Ancrese

Only **15 minutes walk from the campsite**, these beaches are the **longest stretches of sand in Guernsey**. The bays have a gentle slope, ideal for **swimming** and **paddling** as well as playing **games** on the beach. The water is also perfect for **windsurfing, surfing, sailing, sea kayaking** and even **fishing** if you wish. There is a large car park and **toilets** are available at both ends of the wide sweeping bay, along with the **Beach House restaurant** at Pembroke and a **traditional kiosk** at L'Ancrese.

Ladies Bay is a **family-friendly beach** on the north-east corner of Guernsey. Situated on the edge of L'Ancrese Common, Ladies Bay is popular with families due to its **play park** up at the top of the grassy verge. There is **good parking** and a small local coffee shop / kiosk. There are also **public toilets** at the top of the slipway onto the beach.

## Buses

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To catch a bus into the town **St. Peter Port**, wait on the **campsite side** of the road near the crossing to the **Alliance Supermarket**.

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On **weekdays**, there is a bus every **half an hour at 16 minutes past** or **47 minutes past the hour from 6 am till 8pm**. Their **numbers are 12 and 13**. For the most accurate information, please refer to [buses.gg](https://buses.gg)

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## Bike Rental



The campsite has a partnership with '**Go Guernsey**' - a local outdoor adventure hire group. They have a **range of bicycles** available including, electric, mountain, trekking, fat, tandem and children's bikes. Tag-a-longs, trailers and child seats are also available.
